

# How to Vote in Indiana

Date: November 8, 2022



## GET REGISTERED BY OCTOBER 11, 2022!

- To Register, you need:
  - A valid Indiana Driver's License or Indiana State ID Card.
  - To live in your precinct for **at least 30 DAYS** before the next general, municipal, or special election.

## MAKE A PLAN TO VOTE!

### Absentee Ballots:

- **Apply for Absentee Ballots by October 27.** Voters must have a reason. Applications *must be received* by the county or state by October 27.
- **Return Absentee Ballots by Tuesday, November 8 at 6:00 p.m.** Ballots *must be received* by this date—postmarks do not count as timely.

### Voting Absentee in Person: Oct. 12, 2022 - Nov. 7, 2022

### In-person voting on Election Day:

- Polls are open from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- **Photo ID Law:** IN voters must present a government-issued ID to vote.
  - IN driver's license, photo ID card, Military ID or U.S. Passport

## WHAT'S ON THE BALLOT?

- **Indiana State Senate:** 25 out of 50 seats
- **Indiana State House:** All 100 seats
- **Indiana Secretary of State**
- **Indiana Treasurer**
- **Indiana Auditor**
- **US Senate:** 1 seat
- **US House:** All 9 seats
